

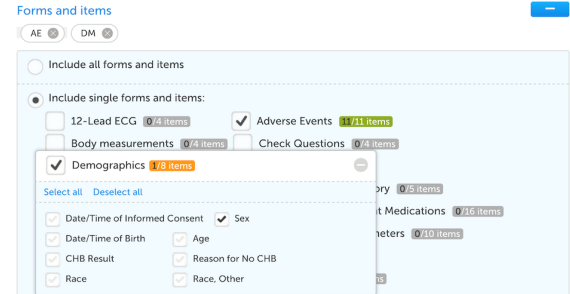
Export, preview and graphically display data

1 Export

- Being able to easily export data is very important. Sometimes it is more efficient to review data via the export than going through form by form.

The export allows you to select the content you want by being able to choose what subjects, visits and forms to include. Even items from different forms can be selected to generate the preferred output.

Pick and choose, be a better monitor.



2 Preview

- If you don't want to work with the data externally you choose preview instead of export.

With the preview feature you are able to preview the content directly on the screen and click any cell to access the underlying eCRF page.

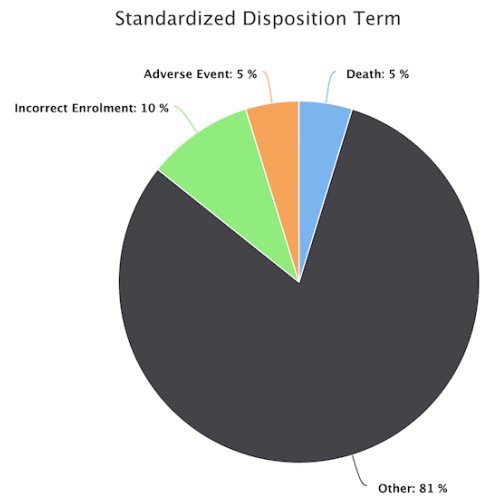
